- 2. Resolution 21-0928B, the disclosure that authorizes the use of, or issuance of, Certificates of Participation (COP) by the district, was reviewed by the board. Claude Lockhart, Jr., Vice President for Stifel Financial Corporation gave a final overview on the Certificate of Participation process. The goal of the COPs is to provide 100% funding of the district's current PSPRS actuarial liability. The board voted unanimously to pass resolution 21-0928B. Resolution 21-0928A, which authorizes the sale, execution, and delivery of certificates of participation in a lease-purchase agreement to provide necessary financing of the district, and the adoption of written continuing disclosure compliance procedures in connection with issuance of certificates of participation of the district, was reviewed by the board. - 2. Chief Schmitz reported that crews have begun moving back into FS132. M132 moved in two weeks ago, BC131 moved in last week, and M134 will be moving in this week.
